#### MISSION-BASED PRINCIPLES

Londonderry Village's first residents moved in on February 21, 1979. Over forty years, our faith-based core has remained our mission-based attitude of love and servanthood, rooted in Brethren values. Our commitment is to be a caring community, provide high-quality health care, and set the standards of excellence in everything we do.

It is about creating a real, family home that values each Elder as the unique person they are and provides a setting that uplifts their strengths and personal choices. It is about helping all of our Elders to achieve their full potential and live their "best life."

## BORN FROM A HISTORY OF PHILANTHROPY

From the beginning, Londonderry Village has placed a priority upon providing benevolent care when a resident has exhausted their resources. In 2018 alone, over **\$2 million** was provided in benevolent care for our health care and personal care services.

### FLOURISHING IN COMMUNITY

Our campus houses adult daycare, independent living, personal care, skilled nursing, dementia/Alzheimer's care, skilled care at our current four Green House® homes, and rehabilitative services. Over 600 residents currently receive excellent care at Londonderry Village.

Throughout our 40-year history, Londonderry Village's mission and our ministry have focused on providing the highest quality of care through a full continuum of services. In 2008, we became the first in the mid-Atlantic to embrace the highly acclaimed Green House® model. As a result, we have served countless Elders in an intimate, personalized environment where relationships have been built and Elders have thrived. In addition, our ministry calls us to place a very high priority on benevolent care to help cover the cost of care for those who can no longer afford to pay all of their own expenses. Our residents have peace of mind knowing that help is available should they outlive their financial resources.

Today we are looking to significantly expand these two important aspects of our ministry—Green House® care and current and permanent Benevolent Funding. Two additional ten-bed Green House® homes are currently under construction and are expected to open in late fall 2019. The combined cost to build the new Green House® homes is \$6.7 million. The annual cost of benevolent care is now in excess of \$2 million and continues to climb. Through a special fundraising campaign, we seek to raise a minimum of \$2.5 million to support the Green House® homes and to significantly increase permanent Benevolent Funding to support our current and future residents. These objectives will be met through current gifts, multiyear pledges and through new or increased planned gifts from family and friends of Londonderry Village, like you.

We eagerly anticipate your partnership in this undertaking. Together, we can protect, nurture, and sustain those we serve today and in the future. With your help, we will flourish together!

Created by Dr. William H. Thomas over fifteen years ago, the Green House® concept evolved as an alternative to the institutional feel of traditional nursing homes. This concept is revolutionizing the long-term care industry. Green House® homes are designed with not only the appearance, but also the function and feel, of a real residential home.



#### INTIMATE, FAMILY-LIKE SIZE

Each Green House® is home to no more than ten residents. We call them **Elders** to emphasize how they are each empowered to continue *growing*. They are experienced, able teachers of life wisdom with a treasured, rich history. They aren't here to die or to diminish in their capabilities and shrink

their new life experiences. Londonderry Village's Green Houses are here to add life to their years. These smaller homes return control, dignity and a sense of well-being to Elders while providing highly personalized care. It is a real family environment where convivium, joy, and relationships flourish.

#### **OUR UNIQUE POSITION**

With over ten years of experience operating Green Houses, Londonderry Village is already recognized as the leader in providing an alternative to "traditional" nursing home care, maintaining our five-star rating for the past two years. In addition to our Green House® philosophy, we've also adopted the Best Life and Eden Alternative culture change models which focus on both quality of care and quality of life.

This \$2.1 million capital campaign includes funding for Green House construction costs and benevolent care funding.




