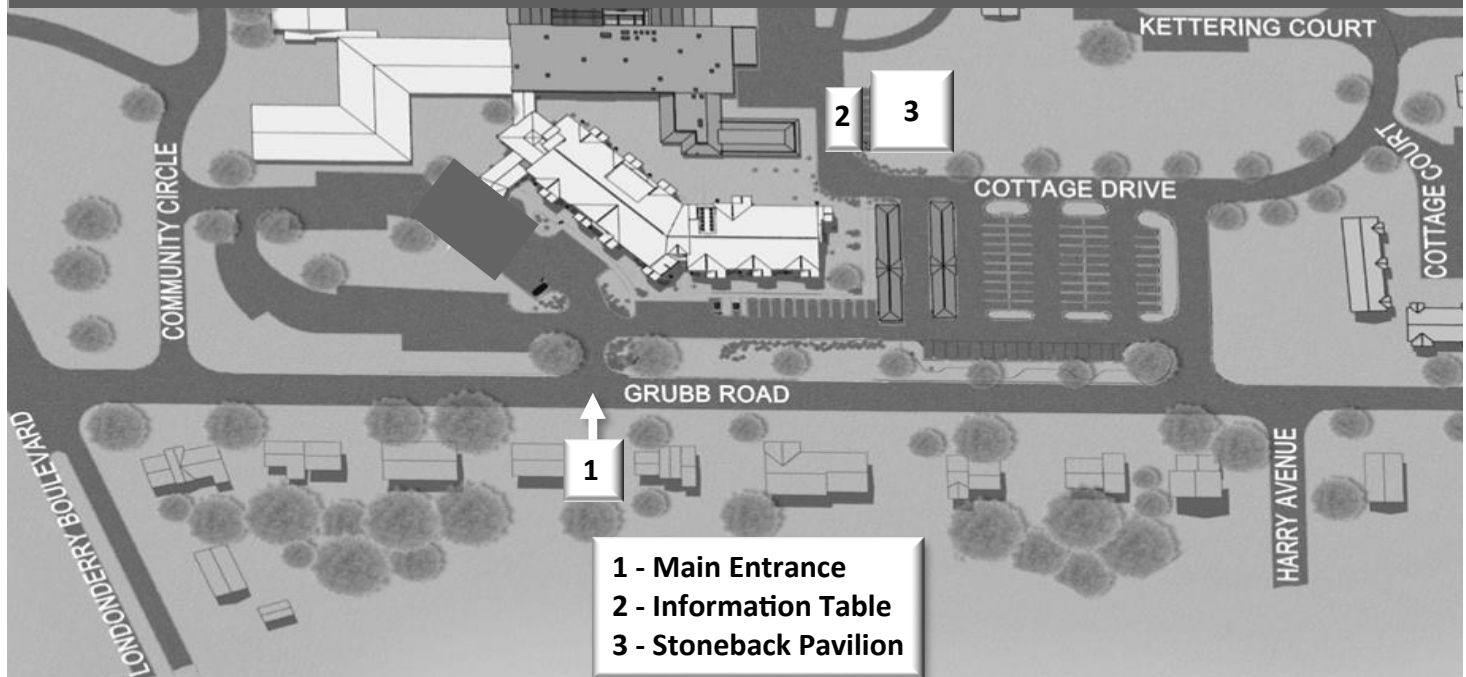

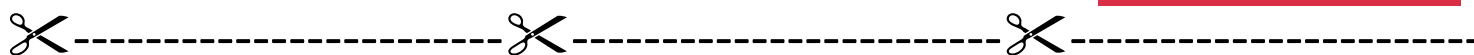



A CUT ABOVE THE REST...

Resident Spotlight Bob Engelman

Resident Bob Engelman moved to Londonderry Village with his wife, Mary, 21 years ago. Bob remembers it being double reason for celebration as the date was the fourth of July. As a member of The Thousands Trails campgrounds Bob had friends who lived at Londonderry Village so he knew it would be a good place to settle.

Bob was born and raised on a farm in Quakertown, PA where he learned to drive a tractor at age six. He spent twenty-five years on a farm before taking a job as a Master Mechanic for the demolition contract company, Geppart Brothers. At Geppart Brothers Bob was responsible for maintaining and repairing the large industrial demolition machinery used at the worksites.

Before moving to Londonderry Village Bob and Mary, lived in Telford, PA, just south of Quakertown. Once Bob retired the couple, as Bob puts it, *"sold their house and went for an adventure on the road."* Bob and Mary took a five-year RV trip through the United States and Canada. He says Yellowstone National Park and Icefield Park in Canada stood out as favorite places they visited. Bob and Mary also spent some time in Florida, however Londonderry Village would ultimately become their home.

Bob says he moved into his home at the Village and it was not quite a week before another resident approached him about helping maintain the campus lawns. Bob did not hesitate. He saddled up on the riding mower and, well, the rest is history. Bob's been mowing the campus lawn for twenty-one years to be exact... as long as he has lived here at the Village. Having spent his life around heavy machinery Bob has also able to repair our mowers over the years.

On days when Bob mows, he starts bright and early at eight o'clock in the morning and usually finishes by about three o'clock in the afternoon. He does take a break for lunch, grabbing a bite to eat at Londonderry Village's Café. With the size of our campus Bob likes to mow three days per week. Bob says he truly enjoys mowing the lawn. Being around machinery and equipment his whole life, the equipment is familiar to him. Bob admits that

being on the mower is nothing compared to the heavy equipment he worked with during his career. While the mower isn't as large as the machinery he spent time around during his career Bob still, of course, wears ear protection while on the mower. Bob also mentioned that he does not do it alone. There are some other residents who also volunteer to help maintain our campus lawn. Bob says he and resident volunteer Art Gingrich often work together and that they get along well and enjoy one another's company. If you are joining us for our concert series being held at our campus, it will have been Bob and Art who will kept the lawn in top condition for your enjoyment.

Bob says the best thing about mowing the lawn is that it keeps him active and busy. Plus he feels blessed to be able to give back to the community through the volunteer work he does. He says that even though he's experienced some health challenges he still likes to be active and enjoys being outdoors, too! When Bob isn't volunteering he enjoys walking and walks a few days a week as well as weekends. He likes to get up early, around 5:30 a.m. spending about an hour walking two miles. Bob also enjoys spending time at the Village's fitness center, specifically the exercise room.

While Bob's main volunteer activity, mowing the lawn isn't the only volunteering Bob does at the Village. He is also active with the campus recycling program. Bob's wife Mary also does volunteer work as she enjoys keeping our Stoneback Library operating and organized. Bob says "it is nice that they have each found something that they enjoy and also helps the community".

We asked Bob what advice he'd give people who are considering moving to Londonderry Village.

His advice is simply this... *"don't wait too long to get here"*. Bob adds that he encourages people get acquainted with all the different benefits of being at Londonderry Village and be sure to give yourself time to enjoy the many amenities and volunteer opportunities. There is lots to enjoy!



The Good Samaritan Fund

LONDONDERRY VILLAGE is a senior living community nestled in the farm lands of Lebanon County, Pennsylvania. Registered as a not for profit charitable organization, we provide independent living housing, personal care, dementia care and skilled nursing care in a traditional environment as well as in our Green House® homes. Londonderry Village is a Christian community where seniors have fun, stay fit, remain socially active, and receive the supportive services they need, when they need them. Residents and staff genuinely care for one another and everyone on campus knows that the Good Samaritan Fund is there should an elder have a need.

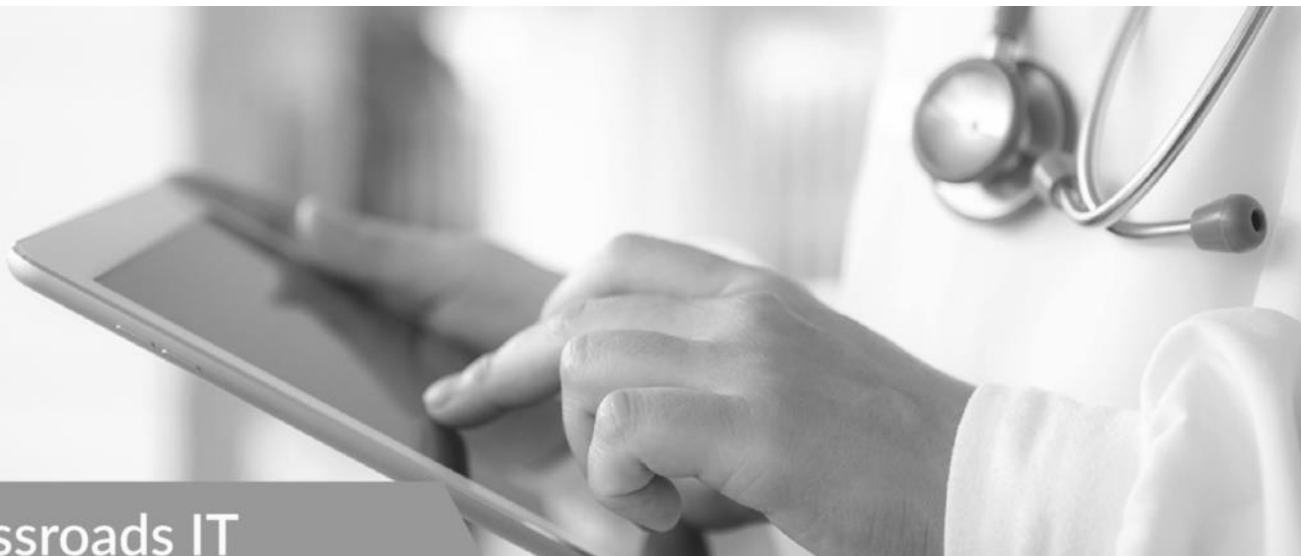
THE GOOD SAMARITAN FUND is a benevolent fund established by the Londonderry Village Board of Directors to help cover the cost of Skilled Care or Personal Care for residents who can no longer afford to pay all of their own expenses. In 2000, Londonderry Village benevolent care losses covered by the Fund were a little over \$400,000. Today these losses are in excess of \$2 million per year. The rapid widening of this gap can be attributed to several factors, including increased costs, lack of government reimbursements and the rise in life expectancy. The cost of providing basic care to residents is impacted by employee wages and health insurance, as well as resident food, housing, utilities and prescription medications. People are living longer healthier lives, but when they do get sick, they are requiring increasingly more expensive therapies. Medicare and Medicaid, the government programs designed to help indigent and elderly individuals, do not cover the entire costs of providing quality resident care for their beneficiaries. Medicare only pays, at most, for 100 days of nursing care. Medicaid does not pay the entire costs of care for those in skilled nursing, and pays *nothing* for residents in Personal Care or Independent Living. We must make up the difference. Since the founding of Londonderry Village in 1979, no resident has been asked to leave their home because they were not able to pay.

The mission and ministry of Londonderry Village is to provide an exceptional place to live and quality health care when needed. Residents have peace of mind knowing that help is close at hand and that the Good Samaritan Fund is there to assist them should they outlive their personal financial resources. We are grateful to the many caring donors who make the Good Samaritan Fund possible.

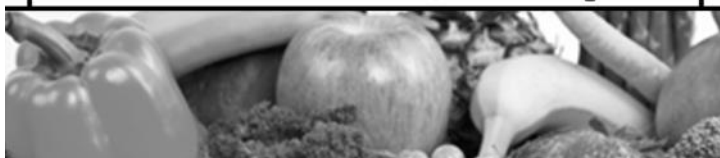

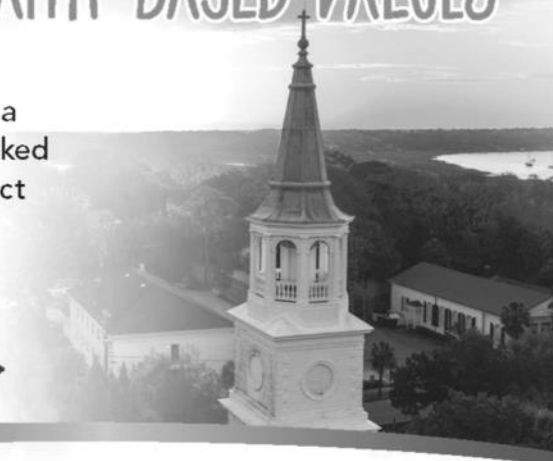
